About Schloss Hohenkammer



Located thirty minutes north of Munich, Hohenkammer is a rural village with a 1200-year history, offering everything that natives and visitors alike cherish about Bavaria: a picturesque, quaint place with an historic castle, surrounded by a natural landscape that exudes peace and tranquillity.

The conference will take place in Schloss Hohenkammer, Munich Re's new seminar venue. Schloss Hohenkammer, whose foundations date back to the 15th century, is a well-preserved German Renaissance castle surrounded by a moat.

If you come by train to Munich's main station, take the S-Bahn #2 to Petershausen (35 minutes). From there, it is about a 10 minute drive by taxi. If you arrive by airplane, it takes about 30 minutes by taxi from Munich airport.
