

Overall Vision of the agricultural statistics is to produce data on agriculture to meet the current and future users needs in an efficient manner with a berable burden on data producers.




Coverage of Agricultural Statistics

All Aspects of agriculture including economic, environmental and social dimensions ...


Production, Cultivation, Price, value chain, cost, fertilizer usage, insurance, social protection of farmers, transportation, consumption, demand and etc.....

Agricutural Statistics Governments make inaccurate decisions about Agricultural Policies



- **Census**: Every 5 years
- **Sample Surve**y : Annually . Method : Area Frame Saampling Survey
- **Registration**: Registered Data through official systems. Strong control mechanism
- **Results** : Announced Annually and Geo-Rerefenced

European Union

- **Census**: Farm Structure Census: Every 10 years. Land Use, Livestocks and labor force and etc)
- Sample Survey: Every Second Year. Method: Stratified Sampling. Survey types and periods changes depending on the country's needs and policies. Large farms surveyed
- Registration : Registered Data through official systems . Very efficient and Strong registration System with strong control mechanism
- Results: Announced Annually and Geo-Referenced




