Dirk Reinhard graduated in Industrial Engineering and Management and has more than ten years experience in the sustainability and finance industry sector. From 2001 to 2004, he was responsible for sustainable investment in the Environmental Management Unit of Munich Reinsurance Company, a global leader in the reinsurance field, and has published numerous articles on this subject.

Prior to joining Munich Re, he worked for oekom research AG as a sustainability analyst in the period from 1995 to 2000.

In April 2004, Dirk Reinhard was appointed Vice-Chairman of the Munich Re Foundation. He is responsible for the foundation's finances as well as the microinsurance programme including the publications "Protecting the Poor – A microinsurance compendium Vol I and II" edited by Craig Churchill. He was furthermore involved in the recently published publication series "The Landscape of Microinsurance in ...". From 2008-2014, Dirk Reinhard was elected as a member of the board of the Microinsurance Network.
