represented by 39 members of our ExCo






Role of insurance in disaster risk management

- (Re)Insurance can play a significant role in managing financial impact of NatCat events
- Increased frequency and intensity of NatCat
 events present challenges to insurance-based
 solutions, contributing to growing protection gaps
- Protection gaps are felt across the globe, and most acutely in developing economies
- Addressing protection gaps can not be solved by insurance alone – shared efforts among public and private actors is required



Insurance supervisors can (and do) play a role...



Actions to address NatCat protection gaps can support multiple insurance supervisory objectives, including:

- Financial Stability
- Policyholder protection and fair treatment of customers
- Financial Inclusion, Market development





IAIS is seeking to support supervisors by...

- ✓ Identifying opportunities to partner with other organisations to integrate supervisory perspectives and expertise, guided by IAIS standards, including with A2ii, Global Shield, IDF, OECD.
- ✓ Developing supporting materials on effective supervisory practices, covering issues outlined in the IAIS protection gaps report and in relation to the OECD Recommendation on Building Financial Resilience to Disaster Risk.
- ✓ Facilitating information exchange at the global level on the role
 of supervisors in addressing protection gaps, with both IAIS
 members and stakeholders:
 - Report from the IAIS to be delivered in November 2023. A <u>public statement</u> was issued in April.
 - Events at the 2023 IAIS Global Seminar (June) and Annual Conference (November)
- ✓ Undertaking capacity building activities with partners, building on the key elements of the IAIS protection gaps report and with a focus on EMDE jurisdictions.
