





- Global dataset of over 300 planned relocation cases
- Foundation for further research, analysis and comparison



#### **Practical definition**

"The <u>planned</u>, <u>permanent</u> movement of a <u>group</u> of <u>people</u> from identifiable <u>origin(s)</u> to <u>identifiable destination(s)</u>, predominantly in association with one or more hydrometeorological, geophysical/geological, or environmental <u>hazard(s)</u>" (Bower & Weerasinghe 2021)

# **Main findings**

#### 1 Global phenomenon

2 Often in multi-hazard contexts; after displacement

 $\mathbf{3}_{\mathsf{Mostly}}$  long duration

4 Mostly single origin  $\rightarrow$  single destination


**5** Community actors/ governments as initiators


**6** Often few households; rural to rural; many identify as indigenous


**7** Many challenges
